Discussion Topics:

- 1. Artists have been making marks since the beginning of time! You can see this throughout the history of art, starting with cave paintings, through to the brush strokes of the Impressionists.
- 2. Today mark making is still a pure form of the artist's unique way of self-expression. Each person's unique marks, gesture or signature are the foundation of a mark making language, that can become an individual language of expression of "self" in drawing and painting.
- 3. How do artists use different styles of mark making to create perspective, texture, shadows, angles, and to make up their composition?
