

Torn Paper Landscape

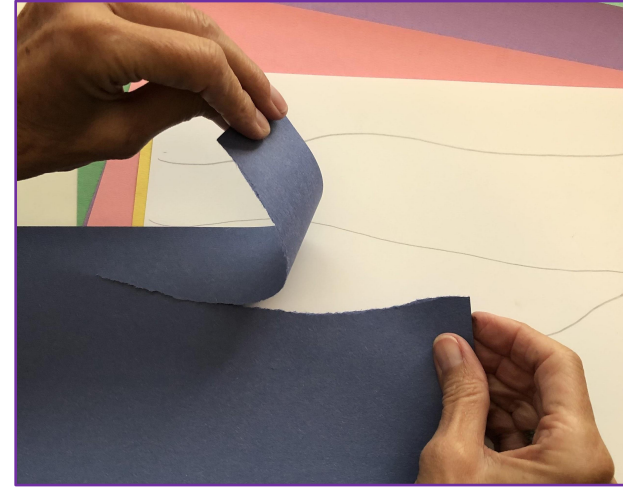
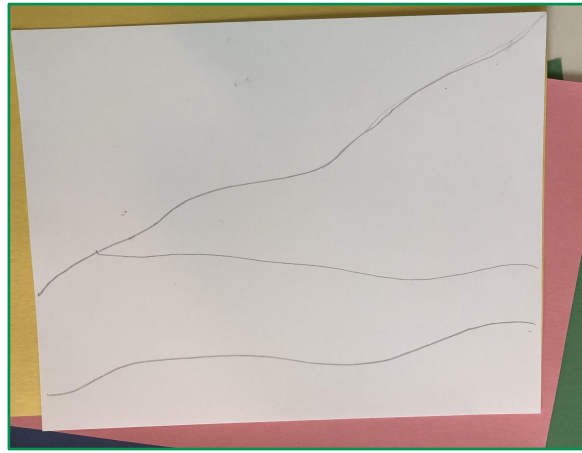
Materials:

- Construction paper
- Pencil
- Glue
- A piece of paper to draw your landscape.

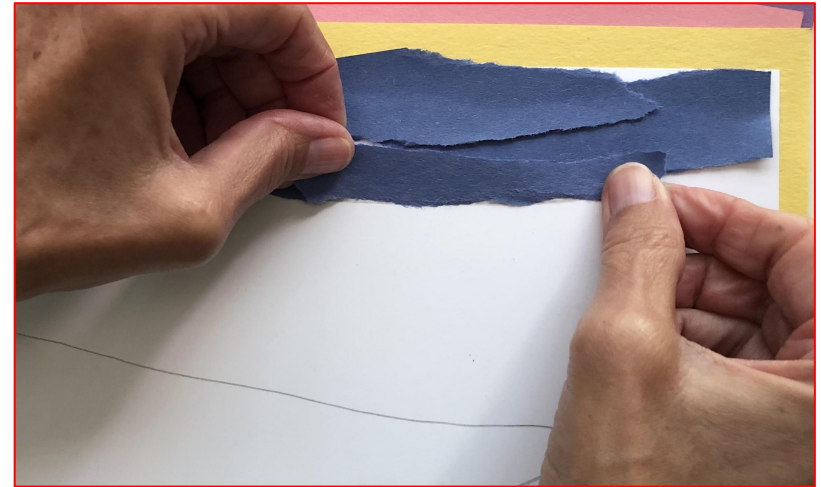
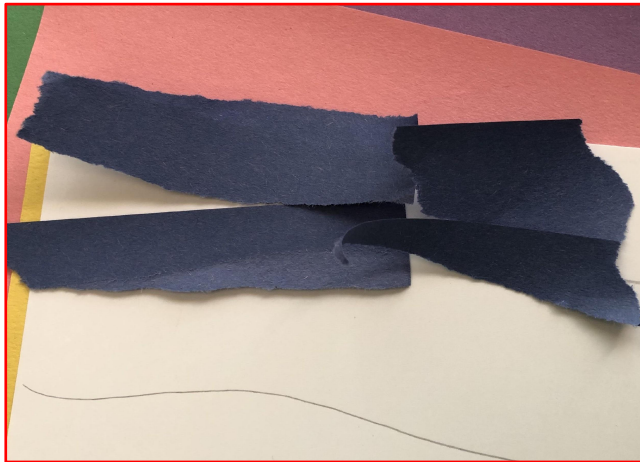


1) Draw lines for your landscape, which will create spaces. I drew lines for sky in the background, hills in the middle ground, and land in the foreground.

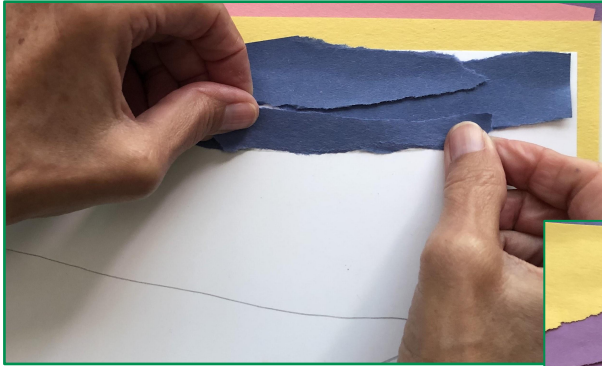
2) Rip the construction paper into pieces to fill in the spaces that you created.



3) Start to glue down the pieces to fill in the spaces.



- 4) I used blue and purple for the sky in the background, pink for the hills in the middle ground and brown for the land in the foreground.
- 5) Next, I tore some green for grass, and yellow and orange for the sun.
- 6) For the last part I used torn white paper for the clouds.
- 7) You can keep tearing papers to add more details to your scene.
- 8) Try not to use any scissors and cover the whole picture with the torn paper. Have Fun!
