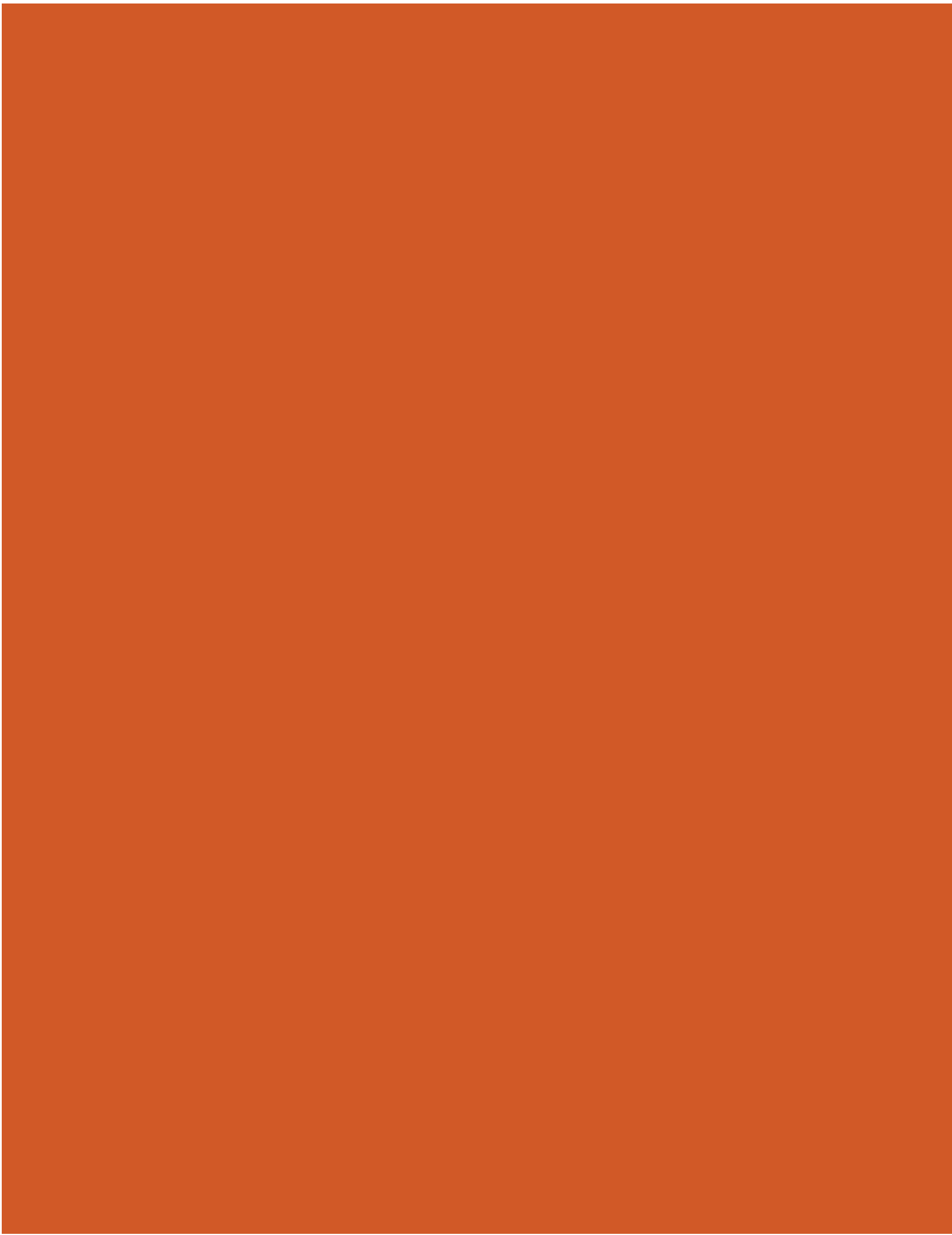

MESSAGE FROM THE CEO & BOARD CHAIR

Greetings,

We are pleased to compile this first Annual Report under new leadership and to recap a remarkable year of increased visitation, Museum Store sales, and content engagement. We are thrilled to report the NBMAA saw its highest General Admissions revenue since 2017, highest Museum Store sales since 2016, and program attendance restored to pre-pandemic numbers. Popular major exhibitions, combined with a well-balanced presentation of permanent collection installations, resulted in our second highest visitation count since 2017.

Throughout the year, the NBMAA presented a kaleidoscope of shows that inspired our public in diverse ways beginning with a celebration of the LeWitt family and robust related programming in the fall. The veritable LeWitt takeover of the second floor included *Strict Beauty: Sol LeWitt Prints*; a monumental wall installation by Sol's daughter Eva LeWitt; and *Steel, String, Spit Bite* featuring works by women artists in the LeWitt Collection. *The Poetry of Nature: Hudson River School Landscapes from the New-York Historical Society* drew high attendance and generated impressive local and national press coverage. Furthermore, the much-anticipated opening of *30 Americans* has attracted hosts of first-time visitors.

Permanent Collection installations, including *American Art in New Britain: The Evolution of the NBMAA*; *Modern and Contemporary Masterworks from the NBMAA: 1950s to Today*; *Cowboys, Detectives, and Daredevils: Pulp Art at the NBMAA*; *North America Divided*; *Early Modern America: 1910s to 1950s*; and *Mildred Thompson: Cosmic Flow* activated Member activity, boosting return visitation.

This broad menu of robust programming keeps our spaces dynamic and fresh for repeat visitors and Member engagement, and welcomes and appeals to an increasingly broad public. Our Education team received over 2,500 visitors through themed Community Days like Juneteenth and Halloween Spectacular, and presented a vast assortment of adult and youth studio classes, artist talks, professional development, student outreach, and touring experiences to several thousand more.

Beyond the walls of our Museum, the NBMAA's content realized significant impact with far-reaching digital delivery on multiple platforms and through collection loans. The most significant loans included Winslow Homer's *Ship's Boat* to the Metropolitan Museum of Art and Childe Hassam's *Le Jour du Grand Prix* and James Abbott McNeil Whistler's *Blue and Silver, Dieppe* to the Denver Art Museum and Virginia Museum. Likewise, Andrew Wyeth's *John Olson's Funeral* was included in a large, three-venue traveling show demonstrating the paranormal in American art.

As we look forward to this upcoming year, we are excited about opportunities for the NBMAA to continue expanding its offerings beyond the Museum's campus and strengthen its impact in the local community, as well as welcome new audiences. We hope to leverage the location of the NBMAA to build more community partnerships, while growing tourism initiatives within central Connecticut.

Throughout FY23, we are dedicated to increasing the Museum's Membership base. Members are essential to the life and community of the Museum, and we thank each and every Member for supporting the NBMAA. We would like to ask our existing Members to consider encouraging your colleagues to purchase a Membership for themselves or to gift a Museum Membership to a loved one.

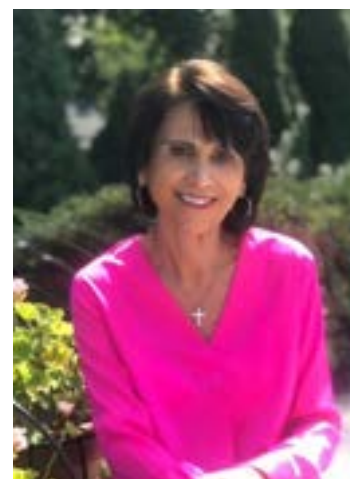


► YEAR OF THE FAMILY

Nearly 500 family members walked through our doors last summer as a result of the Connecticut Summer at the Museum initiative. This program, which provided children free admission during the summer, was so successful that we elected to extend free admission to all kids under 18 throughout the year. Children under 18 made up 10.11% of visitors in FY22, up from 8.31% in FY20, and 6.71% in FY19.



◀ THE LEWITT FAMILY AT NBMAA

We ushered in an autumn filled with LeWitt family exhibitions and programs. It was a veritable LeWitt museum-takeover that included Eva LeWitt's monumental wall installation *Untitled*, and special exhibitions *Strict Beauty: Sol LeWitt Prints* and *Steel, String, Spit Bite: Selections from the LeWitt Collection*, which highlighted women artists from Sol's personal collection. Museum visitors enjoyed dozens of programs related to these exhibitions and the artistic legacy of the LeWitt family.

► AMERICAN ART IN NEW BRITAIN: THE EVOLUTION OF THE NBMAA

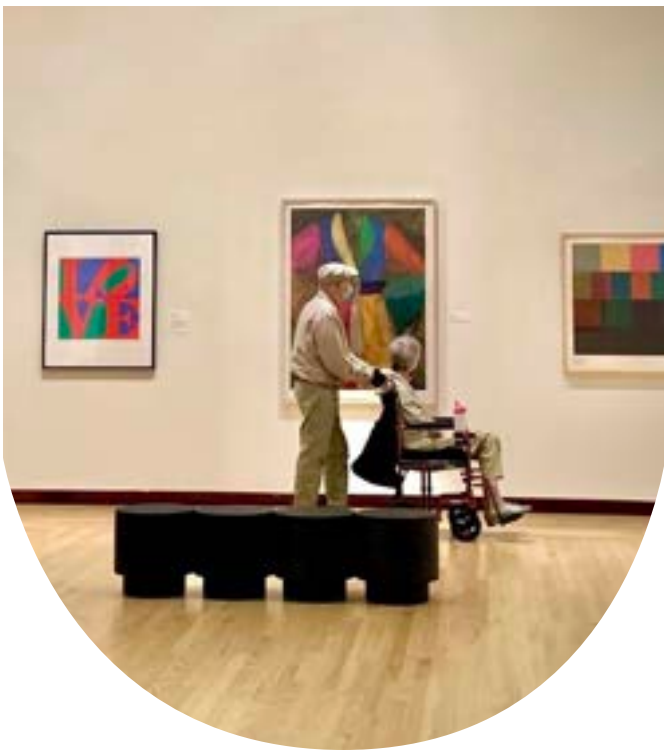
In conjunction with New Britain's sesquicentennial year and the reopening of the NBMAA's renovated Landers House, the Museum presented *American Art in New Britain: The Evolution of the NBMAA*. This special year-long installation features highlights from the permanent collection, including our earliest-dated work and most recent acquisition, as well as a timeline that traces the NBMAA's rich history and unique identity as an American art museum in New Britain.



◀ THE POETRY OF NATURE: HUDSON RIVER SCHOOL LANDSCAPES FROM THE NEW-YORK HISTORICAL SOCIETY

We ushered in 2022 with the special exhibition, *The Poetry of Nature: Hudson River School Landscapes from the New-York Historical Society*. This stunning exhibition complemented our own Hudson River School collection, drew impressive attendance numbers throughout the show, and paired perfectly with engaging nature-related programs that brought in over 1,100 participants in three months.





◀ MODERN AND CONTEMPORARY MASTERWORKS FROM THE NBMAA: 1950S TO TODAY

Modern and Contemporary Masterworks from the NBMAA: 1950s to Today featured iconic masterworks from the NBMAA's permanent collection, highlighting Abstract Expressionism, Surrealism, Pop Art, and Contemporary works. This installation included the recent gifts of Abraham Rattner's *Old Shoe Arrangement No. IV*, 1951 (Gift of Sandra and Howard Fromson) and Joan Snyder's *Screams/Whispers*, 1972 (Anonymous gift).

▶ COWBOYS, DETECTIVES, AND DAREDEVILS: PULP ART AT THE NBMAA

Cowboys, Detectives, and Daredevils: Pulp Art at the NBMAA presented a selection of 17 of the finest and most compelling examples of pulp art from various genres. In the 1970s, collector Robert Lesser became one of the first people to recognize the relevance of pulp art, not only aesthetically, but also as an important reflection of our material culture. In 2013, he gifted his extraordinary collection of 200 pulp art illustrations to the Museum. Today, the Robert Lesser Collection represents the greatest assemblage of pulp art in the country.



◀ NORTH AMERICA DIVIDED

Pairing 19th-century landscapes and genre scenes with works by contemporary artists Neil Jenney and Valerie Hegarty, the permanent collection installation *North America Divided* explored themes of social and territorial division and transformation in America from the 1800s to today.

THERESA & MARK BONNEY PLEIN AIR ARBOR

On May 25, 2022, the *Theresa & Mark Bonney Plein Air Arbor* was officially opened on the south terrace of the Museum's Landers House property, as the NBMAA welcomed the Bonney family and recognized them for their incredible generosity to make this project a reality.

William Hart had constructed a shading structure on the south porch during initial construction in 1909, recognizing it as a prime location to enjoy beautiful views of Walnut Hill Park, but seeking a way to tame the summer sun that bears down upon the porch throughout the day.

The Museum's new Plein Air Arbor was designed to complement the recent Landers House interior renovations, and serve as a gateway between the newly installed bay windows and the south lawn area. Colors and patterns were selected to harmonize with the paint and stone of the building exterior.

Our very special thanks to Theresa & Mark Bonney, but also to Museum supporters and trustees that contributed their time and expertise to the completion of this project; these include John Howard & Wendy Kirkland, David Jepson, Neal Freuden (and the Museum's Facilities Committee), and an extra special thank you to Chip Eveleth, who shepherded us through the local approval process and provided critical technical input during the design process.



◀ WELCOME BRETT ABBOTT

In February, the NBMAA was pleased to welcome Brett Abbott to the Museum as the seventh executive director. Abbott was formerly Director of Collections and Exhibitions at the Amon Carter Museum of American Art, where he led the Carter's Curatorial, Conservation, Publications, Archives, and Registration departments, as well as Exhibition Design, Photo Services and Preparations.

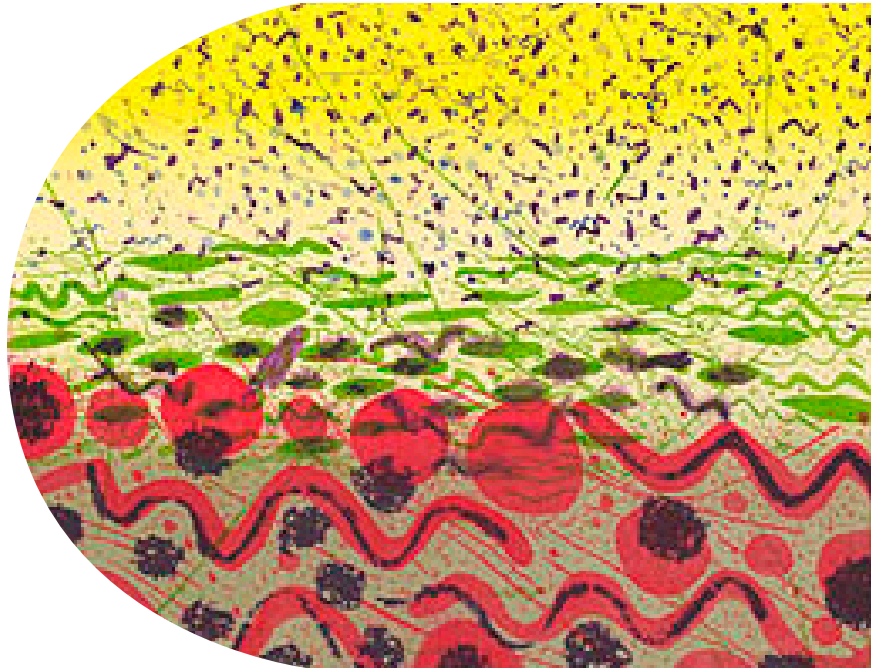


◀ **EARLY MODERN AMERICA: 1910S TO 1950S**

Drawn from the NBMAA's permanent collection, *Early Modern America: 1910s to 1950s* traced the development of two distinct veins of art in the early 20th century: geometric abstraction and American Scene Painting depicting everyday life and people in America. This installation included works by Stuart Davis, Alexander Calder, Jackson Pollock, Thomas Hart Benton, Georgia O'Keeffe, among others.

▶ **MILDRED THOMPSON: COSMIC FLOW**

Mildred Thompson (1936-2003) was fascinated by micro- and macrocosmic worlds of particles, energy waves, stars, and planets. Inspired by physics, mathematics, music, and astronomy, she sought to represent natural phenomena through a distinctly unique language of abstraction. Her dynamic mark-making, color, and compositions visualize the force of unseen energy and forms in the universe, as reflected in this suite of 14 prints, on view at the NBMAA for the first time ever.



▶ **30 AMERICANS**

This summer started with the groundbreaking exhibition, *30 Americans*. Drawn from the Rubell Museum in Miami, Florida, and curated by scholars Dr. Dann J. Broyld, Provost Nicole Stanton, and Dr. Brittney Yancy, *30 Americans* tells the story of Black humanity through the gaze of some of the most significant Black artists of the last four decades. This special exhibition and the well-attended related programming have already encouraged active conversation among Museum visitors.

◀ ENGAGING LOCAL ARTISTS AND TALENT

The Education Department has been successfully identifying ways to connect local artists with our constituents. Through Studio Classes and Artist Talks that relate to the Museum’s permanent collection and special exhibitions, we continue to highlight the impressive level of artistic talent in Connecticut, while providing art-making opportunities to Museum visitors.

▶ ENGAGING AND GROWING OUR MEMBERSHIP

In our ongoing effort to build our Membership base in this coming fiscal year, we have been placing special emphasis on engaging our Members with Exhibition Openings, Members Shopping Day, all sorts of perks and discounts, and Members-only events, such as Thomas Mach’s talks on the role wall color plays in the NBMAA. New Membership collateral has been designed and printed, including a Membership brochure and a non-Member calendar mailing with Membership ask.



DEEPENING COMMUNITY CONNECTIONS



Throughout the year, the NBMAA presented multiple Community Days with free admission. We have continued to deepen our community connections by collaborating with our Community Advisory Committee, engaging our neighbors, and opening our doors to over 2,500 people for Halloween, Three King's Day, Martin Luther King Jr. Day, President's Day, Hispanic Heritage Month, and Juneteenth.

New and ongoing partnerships and collaborations with local organizations and artists include:

- **New Britain Roots** – This series of workshops connected art, health, and wellness through gardening and sustainable food growing practices.
- **Hartt School Community Division** – The return of this concert featuring original musical compositions inspired by artworks in the Museum's collection brought in 68 visitors.

- **15th Annual Global Environmental Sustainability Symposium** – This all-day event on April 14 drew 70 CCSU students and faculty to the Museum.
- ***Piecing Together a New Britain Story: The NBMAA Cityscape Project*** – The collaboration with artist and NBMAA Visitor Services Associate Rashmi Talpade encouraged active participation by Museum visitors in the creation of a series of stunning collages.
- **Plainville Family Resource Network** – This partnership provides a tour program for caregivers with Pre-K children.
- **Southington Community Cultural Arts** – All Access Arts offers tours and studio visits for adults with neurodiversities and intellectual disabilities.
- **CT Historical Society** – The LiveWell Conference on Dementia and Wellbeing explored how museums can better serve people living with dementia.

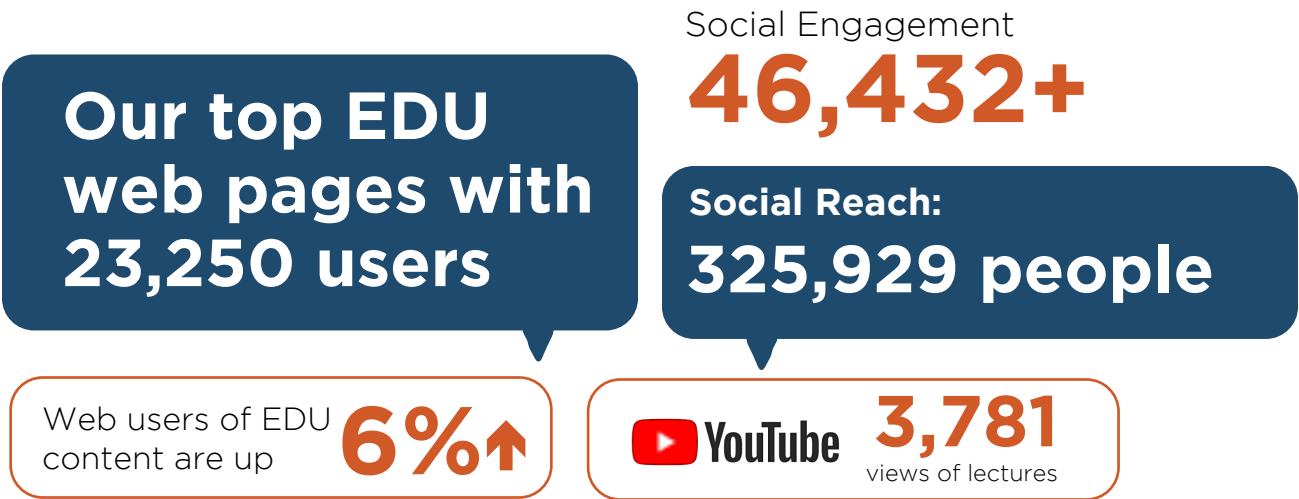

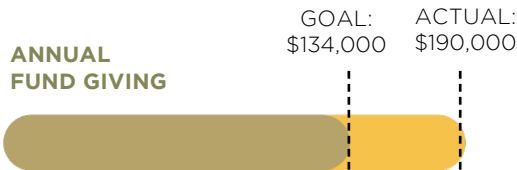

FINANCES

Emerging from the COVID-19 interruption, we saw a steady increase in program attendance, although we have not fully recovered to pre-pandemic levels. Overall, we ended the year with a decrease in net assets of \$4.791M. Of the total decrease, 96% was due to investments at market value.

The condensed financial information shown at the end of this Annual Report does not reflect a complete set of financial statements as the Museum's FY22 financial statements are currently undergoing an audit. Once complete, copies of the audited financial statements will be available from the Director of Finance upon request.

CONDENSED STATEMENT OF FINANCIAL POSITION

The NBMAA continues to maintain a strong position. Total Assets decreased by 10%, driven mainly by a decrease in investments at market value. We had \$506K of liabilities compared to \$25.9M in assets, excluding the net book value of our land, building, and equipment at June 30, 2022.

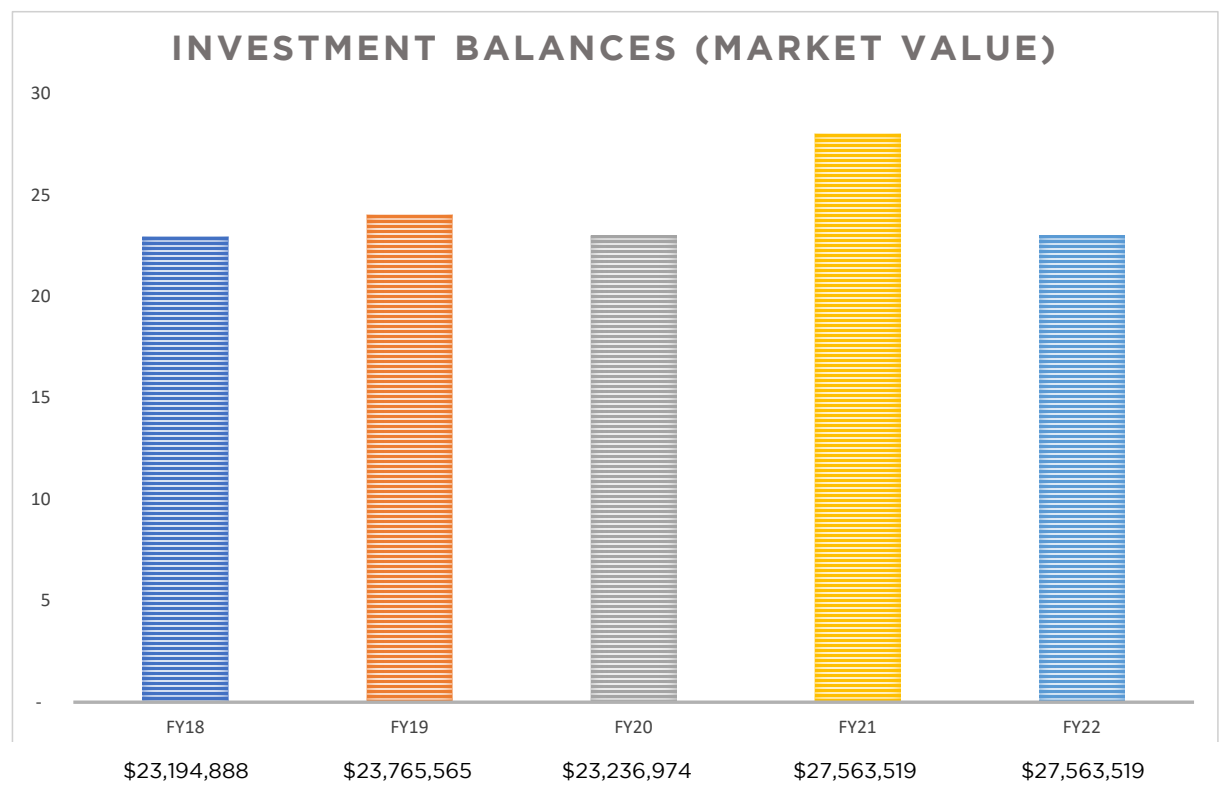
Our investments are managed with the assistance of experienced investment advisors, and performance is closely monitored by the investment committee of the Board of Trustees. As of June 30, 2022, the Museum's invested asset portfolio (after draws for operating support) decreased by \$4.6M and now totals \$23M. Of that, \$15.8 was restricted for operations and \$7.2M was restricted for acquisitions.

CONDENSED STATEMENT OF ACTIVITIES

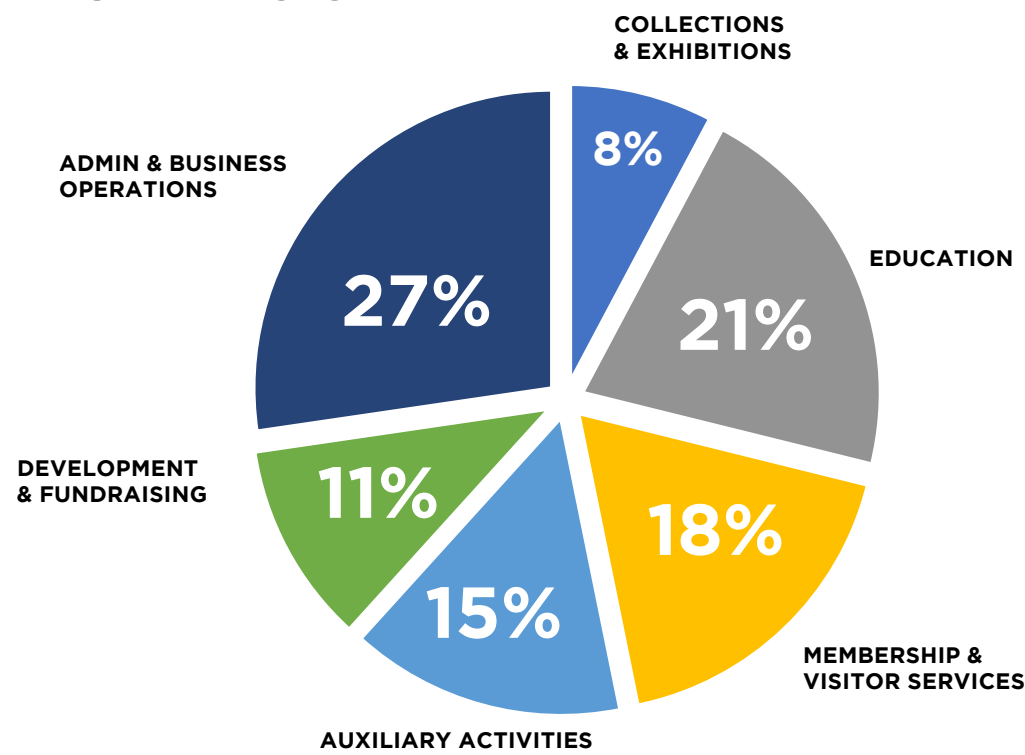
Contributed revenues were slightly higher than in the previous year, driven by the receipt of the Earned Retention Tax Credit of \$472K. Earned revenues had significant growth as we emerged from COVID-19, with a 73.5% increase over FY21. Museum admission continues to grow since reopening in July 2020, and our Museum Store had a record year in sales.

With the resurgence of on-site programming, operating expense increased by 14.9%. The majority of the increase was in our Program Expenses which were 16% higher than in FY21.

NBMAA INVESTMENT BALANCES



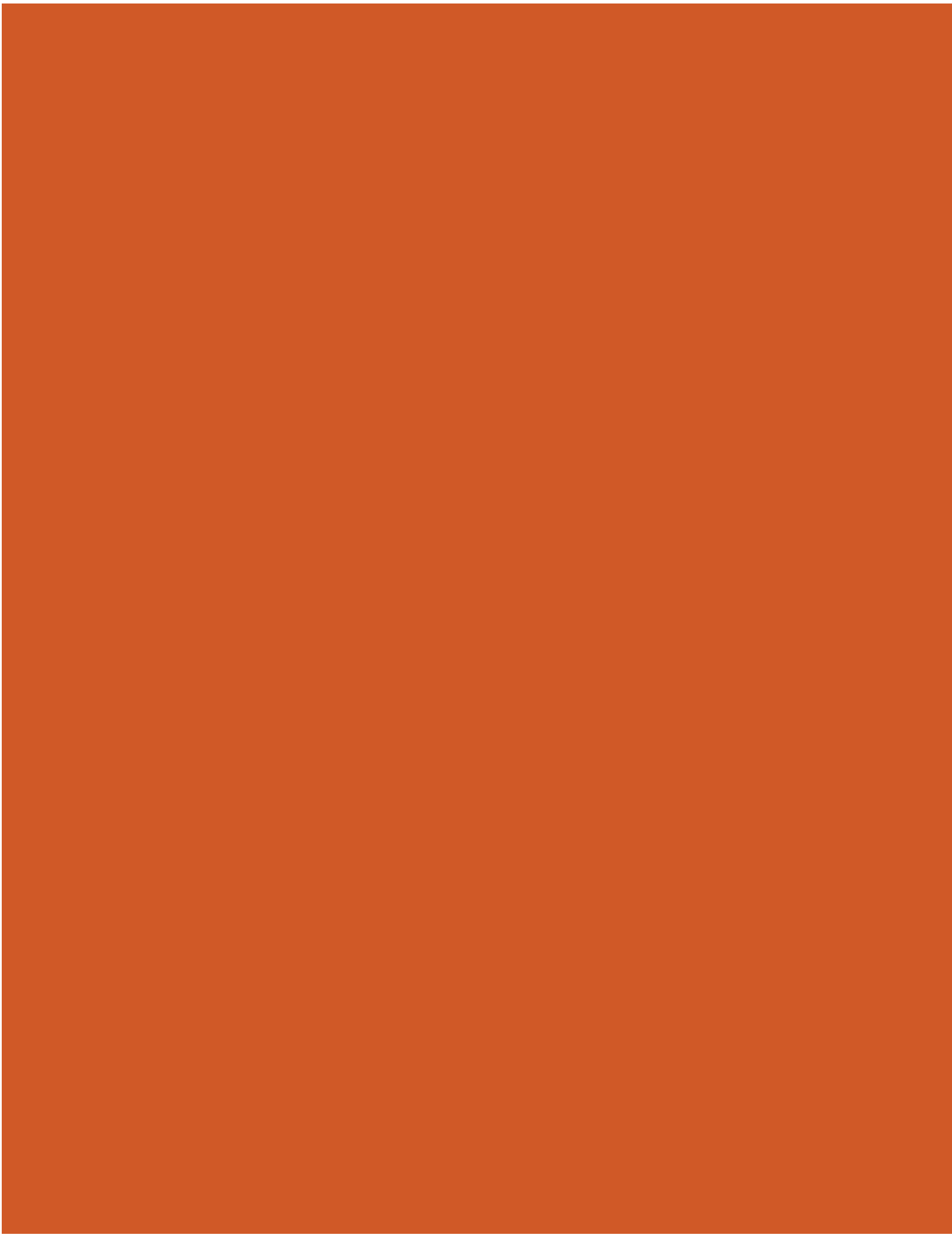
OPERATING EXPENSES
