Dear NBMAA Campers,

Everyone at the NBMAA is looking forward to spending fun, creative time with you this summer. Please keep this first page to review the following information with your parent or guardian as you prepare for your camp experience.

CAMPER AND GUARDIAN RESPONSIBILITIES AND EXPECTATIONS:

1. Arrive 5-10 minutes before camp begins at 9 am, in the Front Lobby. This will allow us to be able to start on time with all of our campers! **Call the Museum immediately if your camper is going to be late or absent from camp.*
2. Arrive 5-10 minutes before pick-up, in the Front Lobby. All campers must be picked up no later than 12 p.m., noon.
3. Sign your child in and out every day. There will be a sign-in/sign-out sheet at drop off and pick up. **Even if you are remaining on premises, we would like you to still sign in and out with us.*
4. Apply sunscreen before arrival. We recommend you apply sunscreen to your child as we will be spending some time making art outdoors!
5. Wear “art-safe” clothes- we will get messy!
6. Bring a snack! We have snack time every day. The snack must have the camper’s name on it, and brought in a bag or Ziploc. **Please note, we do not offer a lunch period during this camp.*

We are looking forward to having your child at the NBMAA this summer! In order to ensure the best summer experience for every camper, it is important that *campers treat one another with respect, have Museum manners in the galleries, and follow established camp rules.* Camp staff will review the rules with campers on the first day, but we kindly ask that parents and caregivers reinforce them to their children in preparation for camp.

***We reserve the right to remove a child from an activity or from the camp if their behavior is disruptive or dangerous to them or to other camp participants.**
